SS-598 is a fast curing, heavy bodied silicone RTV adhesive rubber. This product was developed for applications requiring fast development of physical properties and fast unprimed adhesion. SS-598 is a 1-part silicone that allows handling of the bonded assembly within one hour of application to the substrate. When cured, the elastomer resists typical automotive fluids and high temperatures. SS-598 works well in manual and automatic dispensing equipment.

Cure speed can be accelerated with increased humidity and heat to very rapid cure times. Typical utilization involves dispensing in open air and after exposure to ambient humidity, a room temperature cured rubber is formed.

Limitations

Do not use product on head gaskets or fuel immersion applications. Allow to fully cure before putting assembly into service. Ensure enough product remains between flanges to be effective in an assembly.

SS-598 is available in 10.3 oz cartridges, 50 lb pails and 500 lb drums. This product is also available in customer defined packaging sizes upon request.

Handling and Safety

For maximum shelf life, keep containers sealed when not in use. Keep out of the reach of children. Uncured sealant irritates eyes and skin. Refer to the SDS.
